[1] Project Goals

Objective: “to consolidate recent scientific advances on freshwater ecosystem restoration by identifying factors that drive success and showcasing successful solutions across Europe”.

- River habitats, floodplains and lakes**


- Local, reach and catchment scales**

- All EU member states + Israel & UK**




[3] Project Approach
